

If the New Year is: *Monday, March 15th*

Passover: *Sunday, March 28th*

Unleavened Bread: *Monday, March 29(HH)
thru Sunday, April 4th(HH)*

First Fruits offering 1: *Sunday, April 4th*

**Pentecost/Weeks
(First Fruits offering 2):** *Sunday, May 23rd(HH)*

If the Sighting of the new moon is on September 9th the fall feasts will be:

Trumpets: *Thursday, Sept 9th(HH)*

Atonement: *Saturday, Sept 18th(HH*)*

Feast of Tabernacle: *Thursday, Sept 23(HH)*

(First Fruits offering 3): *thru Wednesday 29th*

Last Great Day/Eighth Day: *Thursday, Sept 30th(HH)*

HH – High Holy Day, means you are to do no ordinary work, you may cook and clean as is needed to celebrate the feast day.

HH* - Highest of Holy Days, you may not do any work of any kind on this day.

(It is important to remember that the Passover, the evening of the 14th day of Aviv fell on a Wednesday the year our Messiah was crucified.)

Wednesday:

Preparation Day for the feast
Passover Lamb sacrificed in afternoon
Lamb is eaten at twilight

Preparation Day for the feast
Yeshua dies at 3 pm.
Yeshua is placed in tomb before sundown

Thursday:

Day 1 unleavened Bread (HH)

Yeshua in the grave

Friday:

Day 2 unleavened Bread

Yeshua in the grave
Preparation Day for weekly Sabbath

Sabbath: (HH*)

Day 3 unleavened Bread

Yeshua in the grave

Sunday: First Fruits

Yeshua's tomb is empty
